What Kinds of Symptoms Can You Clear with OEI?

- Most states of panic, rage/conflict, anxiety, shame, confusion or agitated depression;
- Artifacts that come up during therapy such as headaches, visual distortions, dizziness;
- Physical disturbances: Chest compression/hyperventilation, nausea & throat constriction;
- Urges to self-harm (including suicidal gestures) or addictively use substances or activities;
- More gentle resolution of post-traumatic states for clients with DID/DESNOS/Complex PTSD;
- You can change alters intentionally to get more complete narratives of traumatic events;
- You can remove transference reactions associated with each DID alter (distortion, etc);
- Transference reactions that interfere with therapy (fear, anger, avoidance, distrust);
- Critical inner voices (rejecting, critical, humiliating, taunting, shaming, threatening);
- Distress between sessions contained through simple self-help techniques.
